STOCKLAND LAUNCHES NEW \$201 MILLION WATTLE PARK COMMUNITY IN TARNEIT

Mr Krushka continued: "The interest we have had in our communities in the west shows buyers are drawn to accessible living options that support active lifestyles. Wattle Park's, tranquil environment and access to outdoor open space, as well as the proximity to Melbourne's CBD, make the community perfect for young and growing families."

Lots range from 199 square metres to 516 square metres, with pricing in the first release starting from \$217,000 for a 199 square metre lot.
