
## Live life your way at Banksia



## Simplifying the buying process

Buying a block of land and building your dream home is a very exciting time. With so many things to consider, it can also be a little daunting at the same time, so we've broken down the steps, to help you navigate this new journey.



### Before you buy

Engaging a mortgage broker or bank is the first step to understanding your borrowing capacity and financial position, so you know what size lot and house type you can choose from.

You'll need to do some thorough research at this stage to understand your financial circumstances and the steps involved throughout the buying and building processes.



### Securing your block of land

Once you're ready to buy, you will need to register your interest with the Banksia Sales Team. They will notify you via email when the next land release is available and help you throughout the whole process.

When participating in a Stockland online land release, (if you are successful) you'll need to put down a 10% deposit to secure your desired lot, have a conveyancer review the Contract of Sale and then sign the finalised Contract.

You'll then need to finalise and sign all of your mortgage documents prior to Settlement of your land purchase. Once this is complete, the purchase is registered with the Land Titles Office, and the land is yours.



#### Choosing a builder

We recommend choosing a builder before your land settles so that you are ready to start building. Otherwise you may have to wait quite a while before you can start construction of your new home.









