# Harrisdale Centre Overview

### Stockland Harrisdale is a town centre located within the Newhaven masterplanned community, 20km south east of the Perth CBD.


The centre is anchored by Woolworths and ALDI and includes Five Seasons Fresh, 33 specialty shops and kiosks, with a strong focus on retail services and food along with an alfresco dining precinct. The centre also includes an Early Learning Centre and other key community services.




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The average household income of \$132,948 in Stockland Harrisdale's main trade area is 16.2% higher than the Perth metro average. Population growth is projected at 2.2% per annum from 2022–2026. The main trade area also consists of 62.4% of couples with dependent children which is higher than the Perth metro average of 46.4%.
