A new connected city

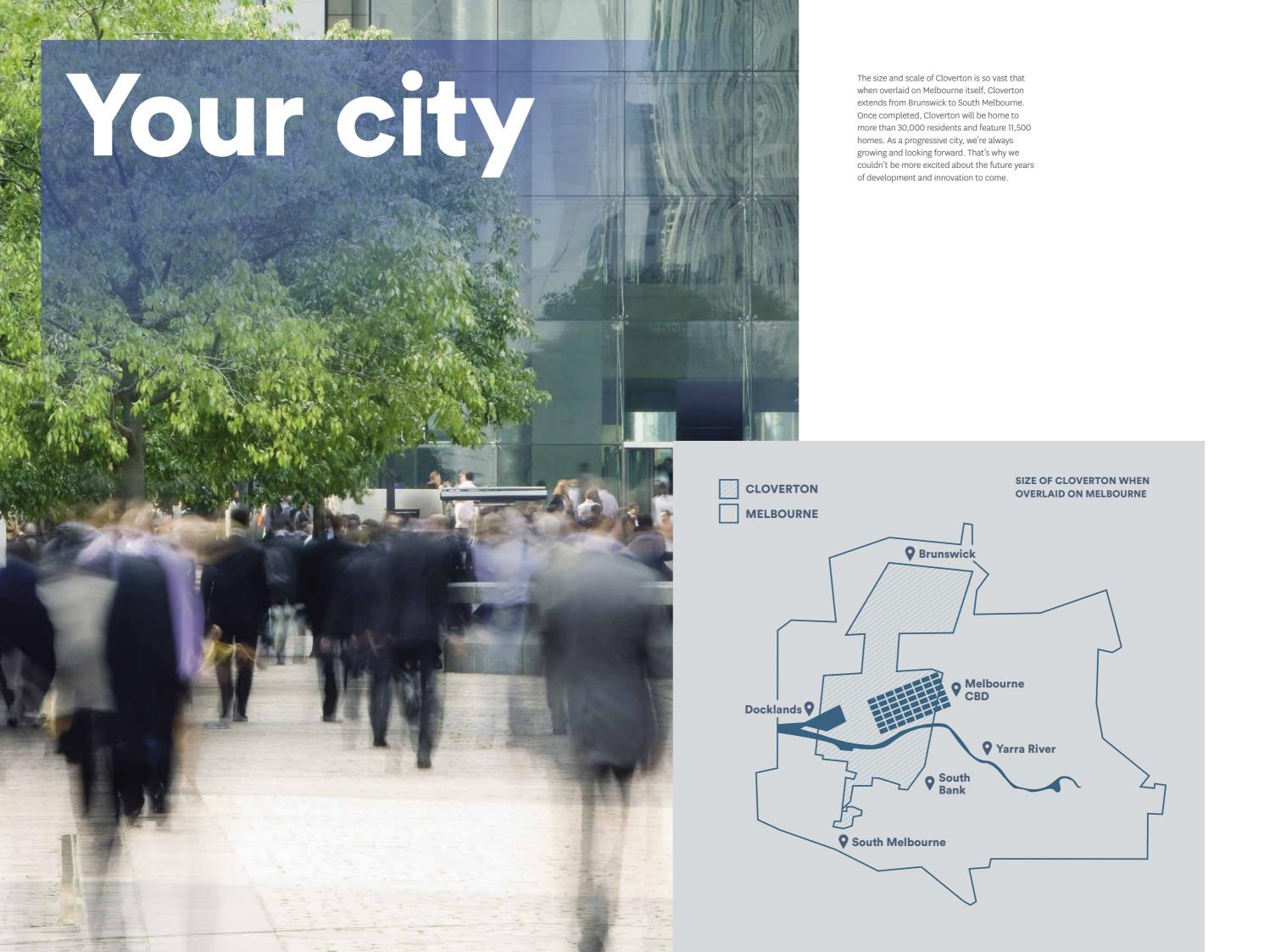
As a part of this transit-oriented development, Cloverton's residents will be able to commute to Melbourne's CBD in under 40 minutes from the existing Donnybrook train station.

An additional proposed train station and a proposed village bus network will ensure residents have easy access to public transport. The current Donnybrook train station will also continue to operate, while a future interchange will ensure quick access to the freeway.

For residents who enjoy the outdoor atmosphere, a number of proposed walking and cycling pathways throughout the entire community are planned to link directly to Cloverton's city centre.

A life lived well

With a range of rolling green spaces within walking distance from all residences, leading a healthy lifestyle has never been more achievable. Whether you like rising with the sun for a morning stroll or running around the park with the kids after school, living at Cloverton makes enjoying the great outdoors an everyday possibility.

Cloverton has been designed to embrace spaces throughout the entire city, with 80 hectares of breathtaking Merri Creek conservation area, 17 local parks and numerous sporting grounds to explore.

The local park on Dermody Avenue features play elements that tell the story of the Wurundjeri people, who are the traditional owners of the area and link the landscapes of Merri Creek and Bald Hill. The play space includes a fish trap net, slide, multi-purpose sporting goals and picnic spots.

Cloverton Vision Centre Reserve features numerous play elements, including a flying fox, swings, slide, lookout tower and a water play feature.

A new reserve on Bells Avenue is designed around a bike and scooter park theme and will incorporate a bike loop with a bike repair station, playground, a shelter with seating facilities, drinking fountain, fitness station, and a kickabout oval. The reserve will be open end-2019.

\$10m regional playing fields that will include two football/cricket ovals, tennis courts, a pavilion, and an adventure playground are opening in 2020.

Cloverton has achieved a 6 star Green Star communities rating from the Green Building Council of Australia (GBCA). This recognises world leadership in design excellence and environmental management, and pins Cloverton as the centre for future economic prosperity and liveability.

As a welcoming, progressive city, Cloverton values the individual and understands how important it is to find everyone the perfect home.
